Ending Telemedicine Sessions

- $\sqrt{}$ The Specialist makes recommendations for follow-up, replicating as closely as possibly how this is managed in an in-person visit.
- √ The telemedicine session is documented and stored (refer to OTN Guideline)
- √ The Referring Physician organizes any tests and shares copies of results with the Specialist as required.
- $\sqrt{}$ The patient is informed if a follow-up visit is required, and whether the next visit will be by telemedicine or in-person.
